China has just confirmed, in its own way, its commitment to the process of civilizational correction of the 21st century, in the human general interest, by publishing a white paper entitled 'A global Community of shared Future'.

In a dense writing of ± 13000 words, it is both an official policy framework, a roadmap, and a framework for reading and deciphering the Chinese state policy, aimed at promoting truly win-win practices, mutually beneficial for every sane and goodwill peoples.

Even more, although proposed and formulated by China, this initiative goes beyond the Chinese policy alone while declaring itself non-exclusive, since being shareable and already shared by other traditions and other pro-human schools of thought, ancient and modern. China immediately refutes in it any form of hegemony and monopolization, including from herself, what is exemplary from one of the main world's leading nations.

In this approach, both in substance and form, the chinese white paper so exposes concepts, proposals, and objectives, very close to those of eco-humanism.

I therefore invite eco-humanists to take note of such a major initiative, to take it into account in their field projects, and to support it, insofar as they will permanently verify a concordance between the published intentions and the observable facts, what is to hope.
